## IMPORTANT ACCESS INFORMATION

**PLEASE BE AWARE OF THE FOLLOWING SPECIAL ARRANGEMENT FOR THIS FIXTURE.**

Safety and security issues are paramount and both clubs have worked closely with the Police to ensure that the game proceeds with the minimum of incident. Blackburn Rovers' support has been set at 2,400 and they will occupy two-thirds of the David Fishwick Stand at the Cricket Field End.

All Blackburn Rovers Supporters will be transported to the ground in coaches. Away supporters will be taken to a point adjacent to the turnstiles and from there immediately into the stadium. Police cordons will ensure fans' safety.

After the game an area of Harry Potts Way and Belvedere Road will be out of bounds for home supporters on foot.

Those fans affected will have to take an alternative route from the home area turnstiles, via the arrowed routes.

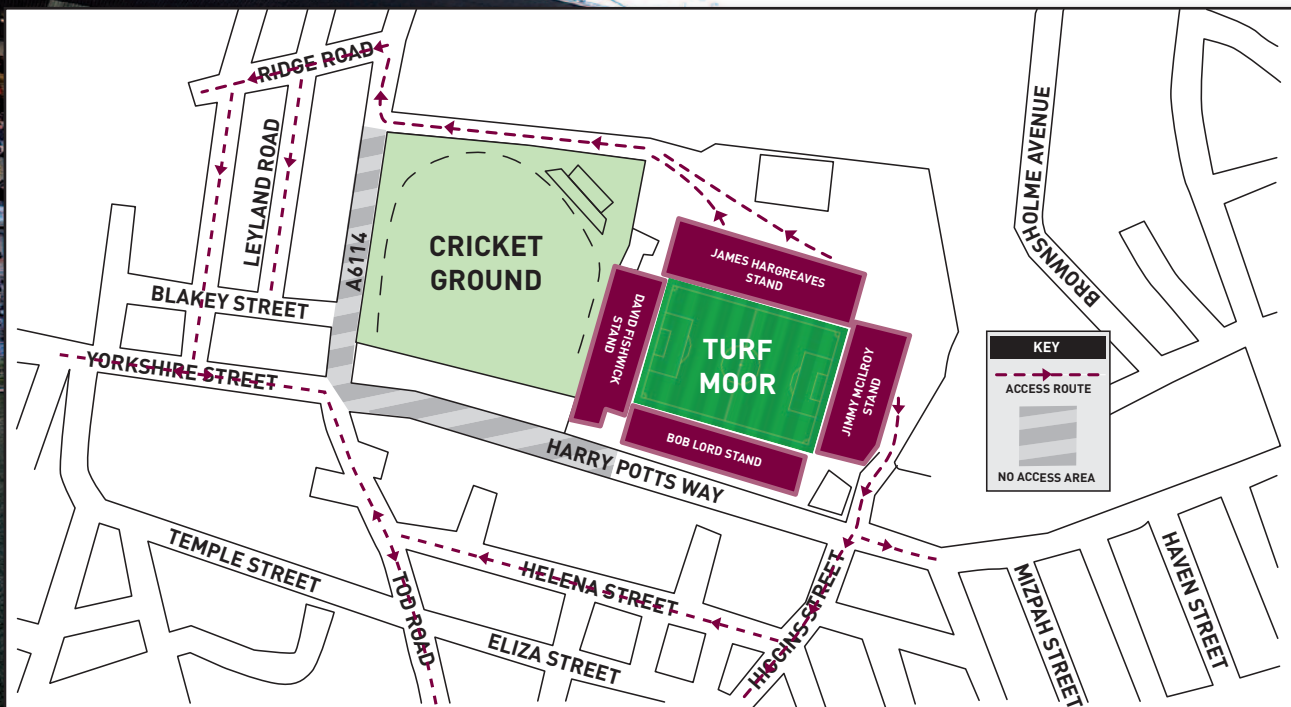
Cars parks can be accessed as normal. **Please see the map below for full details.**

Shaded areas indicate the parking location for all buses holding Blackburn Rovers fans after the match. No home supporters will be allowed into this area. Arrowed are pedestrian routes for all Burnley supporters, immediately after the game. All vehicles on Club car parks will be held back until the away coaches have left the Club.
